PLATINUM 12 POINTS



Undertake a **research project** on any topic from the past. It could be about a person, group of people or event from History.
 Your title must be in the form of a question so you then have to explain and not just describe. E.g. *Why did the Roman Empire come to an end?* Or *Why did England win the world cup in 1966?* Or *Who was the best monarch?*

Project: Identify, describe and explain the causes and consequences of **an important event from the past.**
 Explore the consequences – at the time of the event and now. (Short and long term consequences). Identify positive (good) and negative (bad) consequences. Identify different points of view about the event. *Have there been any consequences for people in your family/that you know? Can you interview them and ask their opinion?*



GOLD 8 POINTS

Collect 2 images or pieces of writing about the same topic in History. Write a paragraph about how they are similar and one about how they are different.

Create a PowerPoint presentation about a famous person or event in History aim for between 6 and 10 slides.

Write 5 short diary entries as someone famous from History or someone witnessing a famous historical event.

Write a short story about a famous historical event or person.

SILVER 6 POINTS

Collect 5 images about a famous event or person in History. Describe why each one is important in a paragraph.

Create a poster about a famous person/event in History. Use words and pictures.

Write 2 paragraphs about who is your hero/heroine.

Speak to an elderly relative or friend of the family. Write down 5 things different about their childhood and 5 similar to yours.

BRONZE 4 POINTS

Collect 5 images about a famous event or person in History. Label them.

Create a detailed spider diagram about a famous person/event in History. Present it well and use colour.

Write a list of 10 famous people from History and what they did.
